The meeting was opened with a prayer led by Jodi Ann and read by everyone present at 6:30pm

**Holy Hour of Healing-** Everyone had wonderful comment to make about this Holy Hour. It was greatly appreciated by all present.

**Magnificat-** These completely sold out. We will be having their publication for sale again for Lent. People mentioned they liked the publication and all the information

**December 8<sup>th</sup> Feast of the Immaculate Conception-** There will be 6 Bread and 2 cups for this Mass.

**Christmas Decorations-** Susan and Jean reported they are ready to go with the Christmas decorations.

**Christmas Masses-** We have enough Readers, a few more EMHCs are needed, Ushers are all set.

**Liturgy Assistants-** Liturgy assistants have volunteered for 4pm and 9pm Masses. At 4pm there will be song sheets and at 9pm they will pass out the song books.

**EMHCs-** Due to attendance difficulties, sign in sheets will begin in January. The schedule will be placed in the Usher's Room. Everyone will sign in next to their assigned turn. Subs will sign next to the person they are subbing for. People must find a sub when they cannot be there and not just figure someone will go up for them; people have become very lax in their turns.

**Reader Training-** This has been rescheduled for January 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 in Church immediately following Novena. Eight new people will be trained.

**Music-** We are enjoying a mixture of music; there is something for everyone. Fr. Jim pointed out we are following all the Rubrics. There is no longer a main choir, but individual Choirs at Masses.

**Holy Communion to the Sick-** A new protocol will begin in January. Final details are being planned. Update to follow. If someone has received Holy Communion on Sunday from a visiting EMHC, they cannot receive during the week. The EMHCs must use a burse, which is a small purse like case worn around the neck with a cord around the neck. The EMHCs are supposed to go directly to the person's house after Mass. They cannot make any stops along the way.

**EMHCs-** Starting in January the EMHCs will place the ciboria on the Main Altar, not the High Altar.

**Food Collection-** All the parish groups that collect food to be distributed will all come together on their food collections. More details being planned.
